

## Standardised Price List

<b>Unattended Funeral</b>	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at a later date and not at the same time as their burial or cremation	
Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£1100
Cremation (funeral director's charge plus the cremation fee)	£1400
<b>Fees you must pay</b>	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee	£995
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you also need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	
For an Attended cremation funeral, in this area the typical cremation fee is:	£799 - £995
<b>Additional Funeral Director Products and Services</b>	
This funeral director can supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or can arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. For example:	
Additional milage (per mile)	£1
Additional transfer of the deceased's body (e.g. to their home, place of worship)	£150
Additional viewings/out of hours viewings	£200
Specific religious or cultural requirements	POA
Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, religious minister)	£200
Embalming	From £130

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this price list for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors.

<b>Attended Funeral (funeral director's charges only)</b>	<b>£1,795</b>
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all the necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£699
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's branch premises) into the funeral director's care	£175
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at both the funeral director's branch premises and non-branch premises	£200
Providing a suitable coffin (this is a wood veneer)	£319
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment only	£75
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to your choice of cemetery or cremation (normally within 20 miles of the branch premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle – this will be a Daimler Hearse	£327
